Parking now available in Torpedo Factory

Public parking is now available in the Torpedo Factory building of Sub Base Platypus at 120 High St, North Sydney. The car park is open from 7am until 9pm every day, allowing cars to park for a maximum of three hours.

The first two hours are free. A fee up to \$3.30 applies between two and three hours.

Visitors are encouraged to continue to access the site via public transport with buses, trains and ferries all within walking distance of Sub Base Platypus.

Mobility Parking Scheme Permits and motorcycles are exempt from parking charges and 3 hour time limit (i.e. no ticket required).
