



Maquarie Lightstation

Old South Head Road, Vaucluse

Australia's oldest and longest operating lighthouse, Macquarie Lighthouse, sits majestically atop South Head. The Harbour Trust is working to conserve the site and provide public access to this important Sydney landmark.

The lighthouse keeper's quarters are all privately leased and there is no public access. The Lighthouse itself is still fully operational and is owned and operated by the Australian Maritime Safety Authority. Public access to the Lighthouse tower is limited to Harbour Trust Open Days.

Public transport

Ferry service runs everyday between Circular Quay and Watsons Bay. Approximately 1.5 km walk up to the Lighthouse via Old South Head Road or catch bus 324 from Watsons Bay. Take the scenic route to the Lighthouse via the walking track from Watsons Bay (allow about one hour).

Bus route 324 operates everyday from Circular Quay to Watsons Bay via Old South Head Road, Vaucluse.

Limited parking is available in surrounding streets.
