Duties	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Conservation of heritage equipment including cranes, boats, lathes and other industrial machinery. Cranes are both electrical and steam ranging from the 1870s to WWII era. ○ Research and assistance in interpretation of machinery
Requirements - Practical	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Volunteers with knowledge and experience in roles such as electrical fitter, pattern maker, fitter and turner, blacksmith, boiler maker, sign writer, shipwright, welder and mechanical engineering ○ Volunteers with no formal qualifications but an interest in heritage machinery are also welcome. ○ Ability to use tools and equipment necessary for conservation ○ Level of fitness permitting conservation activities ○ Ability to work to deadlines ○ Willingness to adhere to safety procedures as directed ○ Willingness to interact with public as required ○ Enthusiastic supporter of Harbour Trust ○ Reliability and commitment ○ Ability and willingness to learn ○ Ability to work individually and as part of a team ○ Willingness to follow directions of supervisor ○ To be at least 18 years of age ○ First aid trained or willingness to be trained ○ Willingness to attend mandatory training program ○ Steel cap boots (All other tools & equipment supplied)
