Naval cottages to be removed following consideration under S30 of the AHC Act
Revegetate using indigenous planting as passive recreational parkland

Indigenous planting to reinforce sense of road within a park

30 spaces carpark.
Interpretation of former barracks and mess buildings

Pump house and PABX to be removed

Possible public amenities.

Interpret the footprint of the former barracks in the landscape

Bridge connects existing path and park
