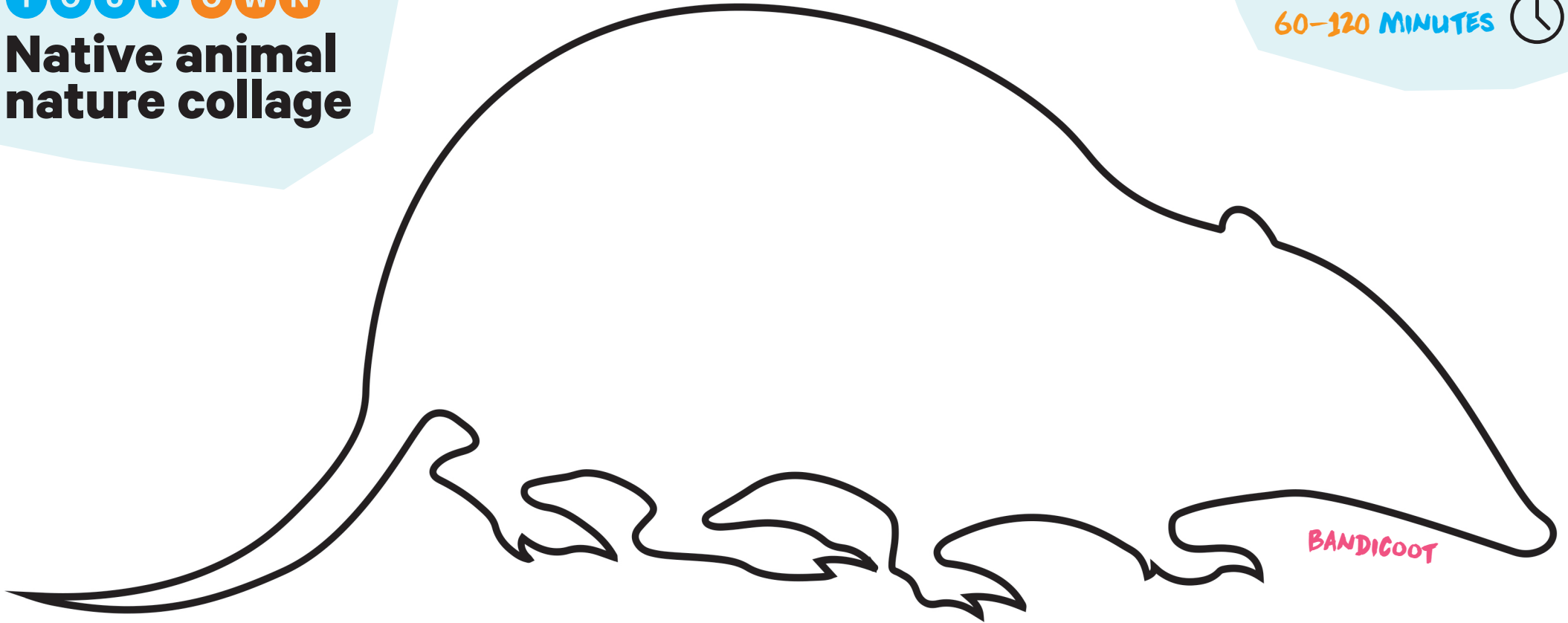


BUILD YOUR OWN

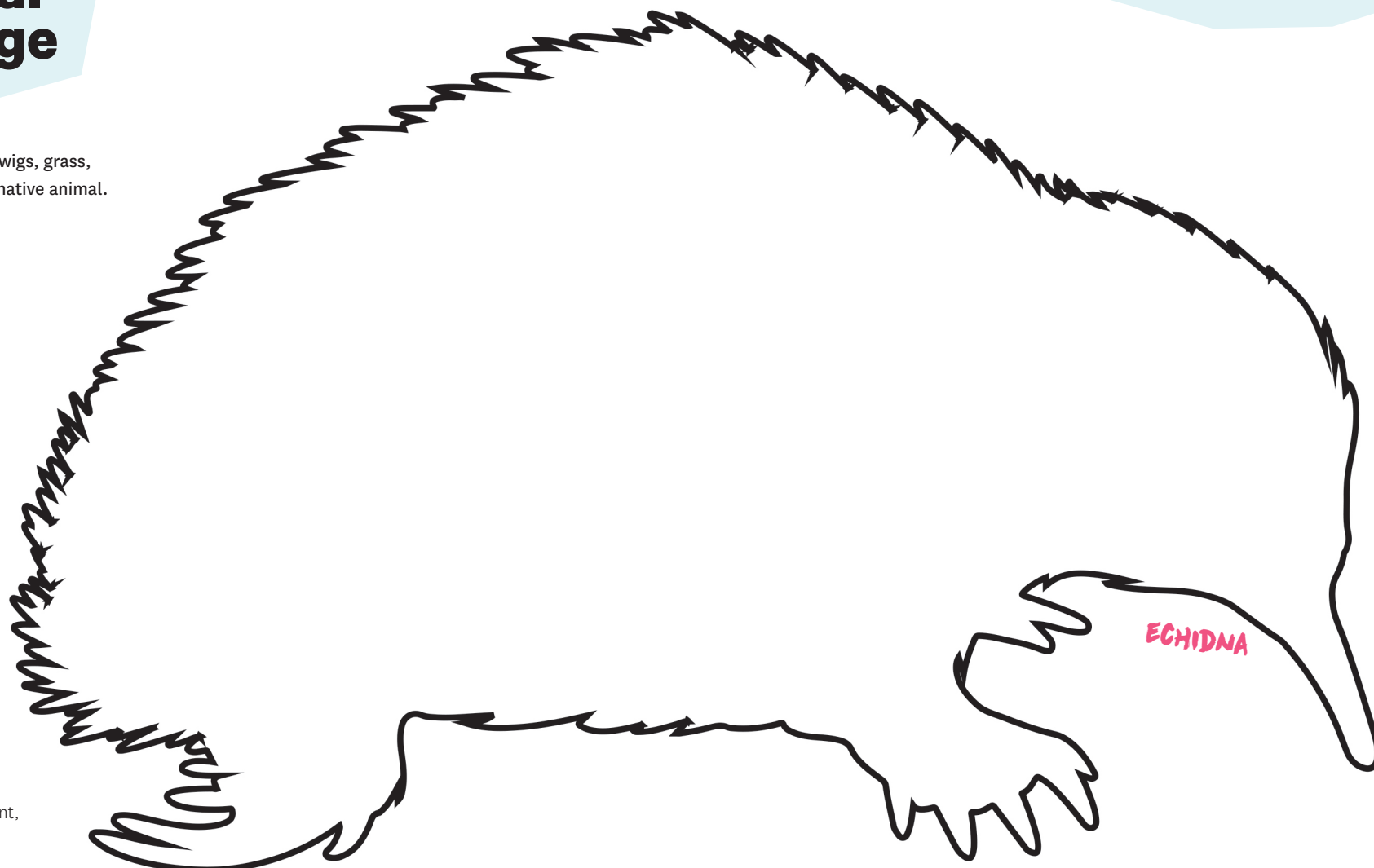
