

2019-2020 SENATE ORDER FOR ENTITY CONTRACTS LISTING RELATING TO THE PERIOD 1 July 2020 to 30 June 2020

Pursuant to the Senate Order for entity contracts the following table sets out contracts entered into by Sydney Harbour Federation Trust which provide for a consideration to the value of \$100,000 or more (GST inclusive) and which:

- a. have been entered into prior to 1 July 2019, and not fully performed as at 30 June 2020; and/or
- b. have been entered into during the 2019/2020 financial year.

Most of the contracts listed contain confidentiality provisions of a general nature that are designed to protect the confidential information of the parties that may be obtained or generated in carrying out the contract.

The reasons for including such clauses include:

- a. ordinary commercial prudence that requires protection of trade secrets, proprietary information and the like; and/or
- b. protection of other Commonwealth material and personal information.
