Important:

You need your ticket to check-into your tour, please bring a printed copy or show it on your smart phone.

Meeting point:

Macquarie Lighthouse, Old South Head Road, Vaucluse. The nearest cross street is Macquarie Street. On street parking is available. Public transport is available to our site, check **transportnsw.info** for more information.

Check-in:

Ensure you arrive at least 15 minutes prior to the start time to check-in for your tour. Tours leave strictly on time and do not wait for latecomers.

COVID Safety:

- Participants will be notified if the tour is cancelled and a full refund of the ticket price will be made.
- Access to the balcony is subject to weather conditions.
- Tours are family friendly, children under 18 must be accompanied by an adult.
- For safety reasons, maximum tour numbers cannot be exceeded.
- You must comply with all directions of the Guides, Rangers and Security.
- Tour cancellations & transfers can be made up to seven (7) days prior to the tour date.
