The Sydney Harbour Federation Trust (Harbour Trust) is seeking nominations from members of the public for its new Community Advisory Committee.

The Harbour Trust manages places of national and international significance on Sydney Harbour, including sites with First Nations, natural, cultural, and industrial heritage values. These places are:

- Cockatoo Island / Wareamah
- Headland Park in Mosman (incl. Georges Heights, Chowder Bay, and Middle Head / Gubbuh Gubbuh)
- Macquarie Lightstation in Vaucluse
- The Marine Biological Station at Camp Cove
- North Head Sanctuary in Manly
- Sub Base Platypus in North Sydney
- Woolwich Dock and Parklands

The Harbour Trust is seeking a diverse and representative set of community advisers from across Greater Sydney – and Australia, more broadly – to play a role in the future of these precious locations.

Nominations close 5pm AEDT on Thursday 10 November.
