Torpedo Factory Renewal Project



Project reaches important milestone with works to commence Artist impression of new parl to be created at Sub Base Platyp

The Sub Base Platypus Torpedo Factory Renewal project has reached an important milestone with the limited tender for the Head Works Contractor currently underway. This staged selection process will appoint the lead contractor with the intention to start works in March 2022 and to be delivered by the end of 2022.

The Torpedo Factory Renewal Project will deliver a contemporary place for the community with part of the Torpedo Factory demolished and transformed into public parkland. It will also deliver a welcoming entry with new public spaces re-imagined and activated, offer further heritage interpretation, and provide further public access improvements.

Since first opening the site to the public in 2018, the Harbour Trust has worked closely with neighbours and the wider community to develop the appropriate plans for the Torpedo Factory - the largest building on the site.

Community information sessions on the demolition process will be held in early 2022 after the lead contractor has been appointed.
