

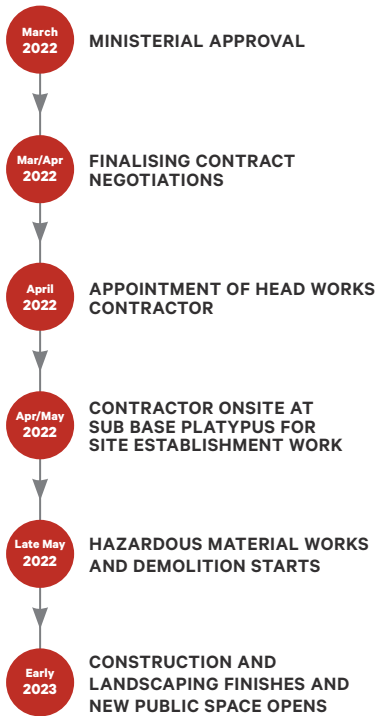

Torpedo Factory Renewal Project

The Torpedo Factory Renewal Project involves the creation of new parkland and public space at Sub Base Platypus in North Sydney.

TARGET TIMEFRAMES



PROJECT UPDATE

The Harbour Trust anticipates that the engagement of a Head Works Contractor will be finalised in early April 2022.

Subject to this engagement, the Contractor will be onsite at Sub Base Platypus – primarily for site establishment work – from the period late April/into May 2022.

Subsequent hazardous material works and demolition would then start in late May 2022. Based on this timeframe, programming indicates that all work associated with the Torpedo Factory Renewal Project should be finished in early 2023.

KEEPING YOU UP TO DATE

The Harbour Trust will provide further updates once a Head Works Contractor is appointed – this will include notification of what date work will start and an invitation to attend an information session.

ABOUT THE TORPEDO FACTORY RENEWAL PROJECT

The Torpedo Factory Renewal Project comprises demolition of the harbour-facing portion of the former torpedo factory building (and part of the High Street facing portion), to enable construction of:

- Harbour foreshore parkland with a series of landscaped terraces
- Landscaped public domain areas, enhanced pedestrian connection to the foreshore and car parking
- Solar power generation from roof-mounted panels and rainwater capture storage
- Areas that explore the site's history.
