

The Harbour Trust is creating new parkland and public space at Sub Base Platypus in North Sydney. This work is known as the Torpedo Factory Renewal Project.

ABOUT THE TORPEDO FACTORY RENEWAL PROJECT

The Torpedo Factory Renewal Project comprises demolition of the harbour facing portion of the former Torpedo Factory building (and part of the High Street facing portion), to enable construction of:

- Harbour foreshore parkland with a series of landscaped terraces
- New public spaces that explore the site's history
- Solar power generation from roof-mounted panels and rainwater capture storage
- Enhanced pedestrian connection to the foreshore and car parking.
